#### **EDITOR'S RANT**

I had hoped that after 55 years of professional practice and the politics related to it, that I would be able to smile as I pass the baton on the professions' next generation that followed. However, old habits die hard.

I was sent a BC government memorandum that was sent out to healthcare professionals last week. I can't ever recall a document quite as undemocratic, even draconian, as this one from a government within Canada.

I would never have dreamed that the exodus of Alberta's healthcare practitioners to BC could have been stopped, but despite Premier Smith's lack of effort, that day may be approaching. There is a growing rebellion by health care professionals in BC against this legislation. I hope it is not too late. If it is, then I fear that our healthcare system in this country is not sick or broken, it is doomed.

To further summarize the summary of the BC Health Professions and Occupations Act, the following are the highlights (or lowlights).:

In November 2022 the NDP government in BC passed HPOA after a motion to close debate. Most healthcare professionals were unaware of what had happened until this Spring. As the process of creating the regulations to accompany this bill continue, and are expected to take another year before the actual effect is felt, a groundswell of opposing reaction is

building up as fears are dawning on those affected (both professional and public).

The fears include but are not limited to:

1. All BC practitioners must now follow health guidelines set by political appointees for their patients or risk penalties including loss of license to practice. 2. Non-compliance with Ministry therapeutic guidelines may result in fines up to \$200,000 or \$500,000 (corporations) and incarceration up to 6 months or 2 years. 3. Anonymous complaints to the Colleges can result in summary suspension of licensure to practice before the complaint is investigated. 4. Appointees chosen by politicians may now enter a healthcare practice, seize patient records, and restrict access to that facility without a warrant or court order. 5. Refusal to accept all Ministry mandated vaccines and therapies will likely result in de-licensure. **6.** College advisory boards will now consist of government appointees only. 7. All "self-regulatory" healthcare professions in BC will be governed entirely by politicians and their agents, using appointees selected by the Ministry of Health. 8. The Cabinet and the Minister of Health can adopt as law in BC any regulations, codes, standards or rules enacted in foreign jurisdictions or international bodies. **9.** The new Health Professions and Occupations Act requires further elucidation of undefined terms used in the Act, such as "false or misleading information", which may be defined by appointees at their discretion, lacking consultation with health professionals. Self governing health care professions will fade into history.

Imagine, for example, having your license to practice pulled or put in jeopardy by a single **anonymous** complaint, before the complaint is even investigated!

This action by the BC government is unmatched anywhere in the free and democratic world and the process whereby it was passed violated its own constitution. Nonetheless, this war on their healthcare professionals is proceeding. I suspect that the wave of doctors, nurses and other professionals that have been leaving Alberta and other jurisdictions will be greatly affected now. I worry, however, that it may actually be precedent setting and move further afield. In my opinion, it is the worst possible approach to trying to revive a sick, perhaps terminal health care system in this country. To totally shut out the practitioners and the professions from all decision-making and replace them with bureaucrats who have never seen a patient or practiced a day in their lives is insane. The opposite approach would show much more promise. Eliminate as much of the civil servant, politician, and career bureaucrat from the formula and those who understand that healthcare involves "caring for people's health" and not just numerical bean counting and bottom lines.

Dozens of healthcare professions, my own included, are in danger of becoming civil servants. If that was BC's intent, then they should have been open about it, banned private practice and hospital clinicians, and put every one of them on a salary with no "union privileges".

Am I shocked and upset? You bet.
